

Policies for ACF Inc. Sponsored Events Organized by the ACF Inc. Executive Board

- 1) Members of the Executive Board shall be the organizers of ACF Inc. sponsored events organized the by ACF Inc. Executive Board. ACF Inc. shall not organize or sponsor a tournament offering less than 78% of collected entries as prizes.
- 2) ACF Inc. membership must be required at the event.
- 3) ACF Inc. receives all profits and is responsible for all financial loss at ACF Inc. sponsored events organized by the Executive Board.
- 4) A tournament director fee of either a percentage of the profit or of a set amount shall be awarded and considered a tournament expense.
 - Standard percentage of profit to be awarded to a director is 70%
 - Standard flat fee shall be no greater than \$500, and shall vary based on the format of the tournament.
- 5) Directors are not responsible for any financial losses due to poor attendance at the event.
- 6) The President (or Scholastic VP in the case of Scholastic Events) reserves the right to require the director of an ACF Sponsored Event Organized by the ACF Executive Board to have Senior TD Status. In rare cases, a requirement of an assistant TD having Senior TD status can occur.
- 7) ACF President, VP, and Scholastic VP may be granted the position of Chief TD at an ACF Sponsored event by majority vote of the Executive Board. In this scenario, these Executive Board members must waive their fee. Instead, the fee they would have received will either be profit to the ACF, be included in prizes, or may be used to cover travel, food, and or lodging expenses for the director(s).
- 8) ACF Inc. sponsored events organized by the ACF Inc. Executive Board shall abide entirely by ACF Inc. Policies and the most recent edition of USCF's Rule Book.
- 9) An ACF Inc. Executive Board officer or ACF Inc. Representative must be present for the entirety of an ACF Inc. sponsored events organized the by ACF Inc. Executive Board.
- 10) ACF Inc.'s USCF Affiliate must be used for submitting ACF Inc. sponsored events organized the by ACF Inc. Executive Board, and it is the responsibility of the chief tournament director to do so.
